Two couples facing two couples/Becket set for 4 couples

- A1** in fours - balance the ring and Petronella turn; Repeat all that  
**A2** 1-4 **Travelling Gypsy**  
 Pass through across the set;  
 Turn a quarter right and in fours walk  
 forward one place;  
 Pass through along the set.  
*KEEP IT TIGHT* - remember it's a gypsy!  
 5-6 In centre - right hand star halfway;  
 7-8 On ends left hand star halfway ending in two  
 parallel waves.
- B1** Balance the wave; Move around one place of a box circulate;  
 Swing partner  
**B2** Long lines go forward and back;  
 Pass through;  
 California Twirl. (John Meechan)
